

Make Your Own Bookmarks (Front)

Instructions

1. Cut out the **front** of the bookmarks along the **dark blue line**.
2. Cut out the **back** of the bookmarks along the **dark blue line**.
3. Paste the **front and back** of the bookmarks together making sure the tops line up.
4. Cut out each individual bookmark along the **light blue dotted line** on the **front** of the bookmarks.
5. Punch the **white circles** out using a hole punch.
6. Tie a piece of twine to the bookmark by feeding it through the hole.
7. Use your new bookmarks to save your place in **The Pillow Story!**

Make Your Own Bookmarks (Back)

Instructions

1. Cut out the **front** of the bookmarks along the **dark blue line**.
2. Cut out the **back** of the bookmarks along the **dark blue line**.
3. Paste the **front and back** of the bookmarks together making sure the tops line up.
4. Cut out each individual bookmark along the **light blue dotted line** on the **front** of the bookmarks.
5. Punch the **white circles** out using a hole punch.
6. Tie a piece of twine to the bookmark by feeding it through the hole.
